Welcome to our parish. We invite you to register, as soon as possible. Registration forms are available in the office during office hours, in the Tower Room or on our parish website. Though a rather simple act, registration allows the parish to know how many families live in the parish. It also provides an official record of your membership and is essential for sacramental preparations and sponsorship certification.

Sacrament of Baptism

Parents must be registered members of the Parish and in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. Participation in the Pre-Baptismal Program is required. Parents must register by calling the parish office.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least six months in advance. Participation in Marriage Preparation Workshop is required.

Sacrament of Anointing

The sacrament is celebrated upon request prior to surgery or at the time of illness. Please notify the Parish office of the illness or hospitalization of a parishioner.

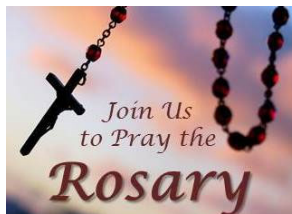


Cornerstone Charismatic Prayer Group

be given the grace to heed Padre Pio's admonition: "Love Our Lady, make others love her. Always say your Rosary and say it well."

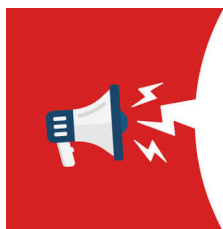

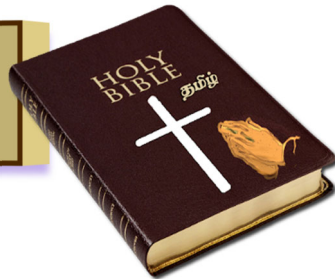

SAINTS OF THE DAY

April 28 Peter Chanel Died in 1841; French Marist missionary on the Pacific island of Wallis and Futuna where he was martyred; destroyed cult of evil spirits; protomartyr and patron of Oceania.

April 28 Louis Mary Grignion de Montfort Died in 1716; from Brittany; hospital chaplain and founder of the Congregation of the Daughters of Wisdom; apostolic missionary whose preaching led to a spiritual revival in his native Brittany; established numerous confraternities for the recitation of the rosary.

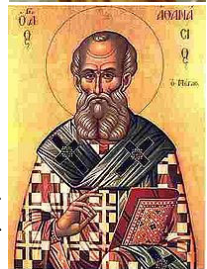
April 29 Catherine of Siena Died in 1380; tertiary, mystic and author; peacemaker with the Church and renewer of religious life; worked toward ending the Avignon papacy; doctor of the Church; patroness of Italy and co-patroness of Europe.

April 30 Pius V Died in 1572; pope who implemented the reforms of the Council of Trent; promulgated the *Roman Catechism*, the *Roman Missal* and the *Roman Breviary* used until Vatican II.

May 1 Joseph the Worker Husband of Mary; foster father of Jesus; carpenter; working man; humble; compassionate; caring; man of faith and obedience to God; patron of the dying, fathers, carpenters and social justice.

May 2 Athanasius Died in 373; bishop of Alexandria for 45 years; exiled by Arians 5 times; one of 4 great doctors of the Eastern Church.

May 3 Philip and James Philip died in the 1st century; from Bethsaida; among the first disciples called by Jesus; preached in Phrygia, died on a cross at Hierapolis; patron saint of Uruguay. James died in 62; son of Alphaeus and cousin or “brother of the Lord”; surnamed “the Less”; or “the Just” for his piety; leader of the Jerusalem Church; an epistle is ascribed to him; was beaten or stoned to death; patron of the dying.

class is required for all parents who will have their child baptized at St. Therese. We will not schedule a baptism until the parents have attended the class.

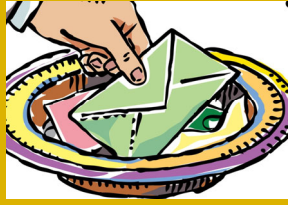
NOTE: Any parishioner that will be a godparent at St. Therese IS REQUIRED TO ATTEND. Those that will be a godparent in another parish may attend.

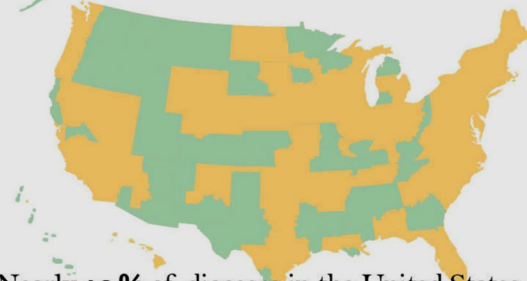
