Sacrament of Baptism

Parents must be registered members of the Parish and in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. Participation in the Pre-Baptismal Program is required. Parents must register by calling the parish office.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least six months in advance. Participation in Marriage Preparation Workshop is required.

Sacrament of Anointing

The sacrament is celebrated upon request prior to surgery or at the time of illness. Please notify the Parish office of the illness or hospitalization of a parishioner.

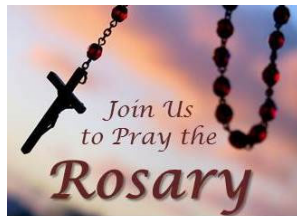

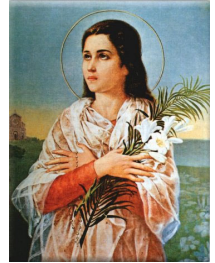

SAINTS OF THE DAY

July 6 **Maria Goretti** Died in 1902 at age 12; stabbed to death, preferring to die than to be raped; patroness of teenage girls.



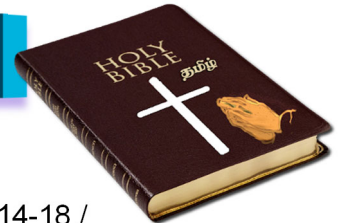
July 9 **Augustine Zhao Rong and companions** Died between 1648 and 1930; 120 martyrs; most born in China; age ranging from 9 to 72; Augustine Zhao Rong was a Chinese soldier who accompanied the prisoner Bishop John Gabriel Taurin Dufresse to his martyrdom in Beijing; moved by the bishop's courage, Augustine sought baptism and not long after was ordained a diocesan priest; he was martyred in 1815.



July 11 **Benedict** Died in 547; wrote famous monastic Rule noted for its wisdom and moderation, and need for obedience; founded 12 monasteries; considered the "Patriarch of Western Monasticism"; a patron of Europe.
