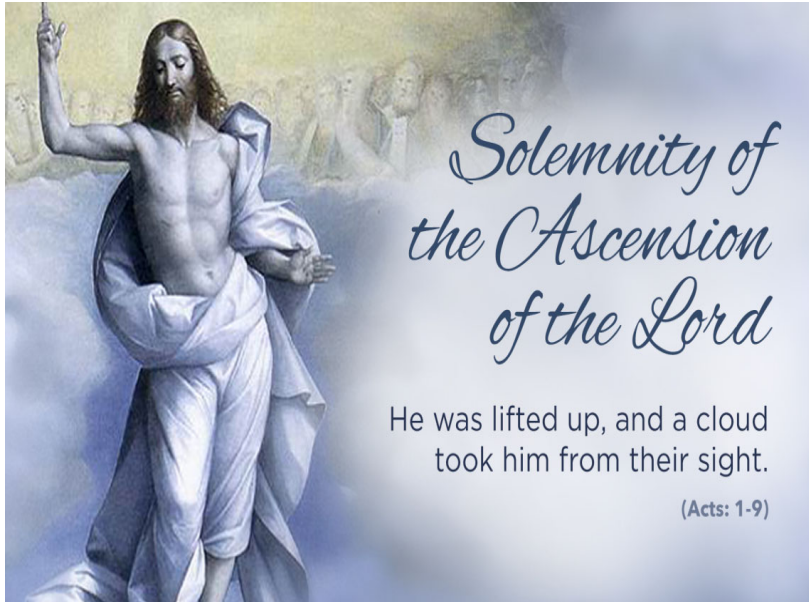

New Parishioners

Welcome to our parish. We invite you to register, as soon as possible. Registration forms are available in the office during office hours, in the Tower Room or on our parish website. Though a rather simple act, registration allows the parish to know how many families live in the parish. It also provides an official record of your membership and is essential for sacramental preparations and sponsorship certification.

Sacrament of Baptism

Parents must be registered members of the Parish and in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. Participation in the Pre-Baptismal Program is required. Parents must register by calling the parish office.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least six months in advance. Participation in Marriage Preparation Workshop is required.

Sacrament of Anointing

The sacrament is celebrated upon request prior to surgery or at the time of illness. Please notify the Parish office of the illness or hospitalization of a parishioner.

SAINTS OF THE DAY

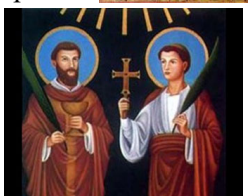
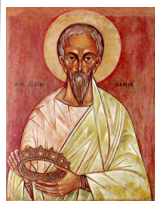
June 1 Justin Died in 165; martyr; layman and apologist who gives one of the earliest descriptions of the Mass; patron of philosophers and apologists.

June 2 Marcellinus and Peter Died around 303; Marcellinus was a presbyter; Peter was an exorcist; beheaded under Diocletian.

June 3 Charles Lwanga and companions Died between 1885 and 1887; proto-martyrs of Black Africa; over one hundred killed in this period; patron saint of African Catholic Youth Action.

June 5 Boniface Died in 754; bishop of Mainz; founded abbey of Fulda; martyred along with 30 companions in Frisia; known as the “Apostle of Germany.”

June 6 Norbert
Died in 1134; founded the Premonstratensians; archbishop of Magdeburg; strong supporter of Church reform and evangelization; devoted to the holy eucharist.



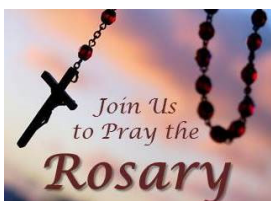

Rosary

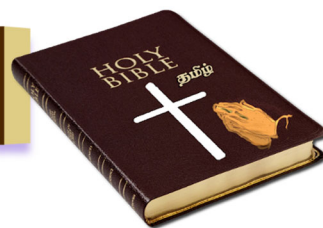

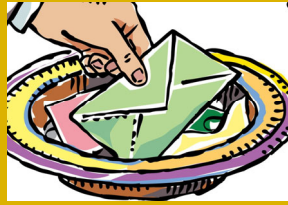
**COURAGE/
