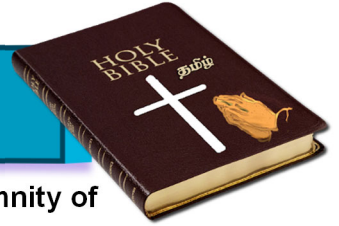


COURAGE/ ENCOURAGE

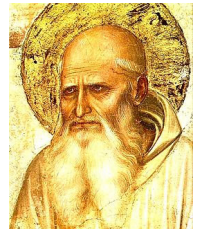

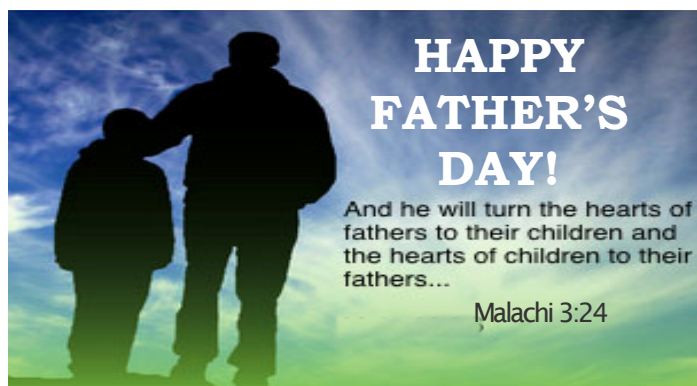
