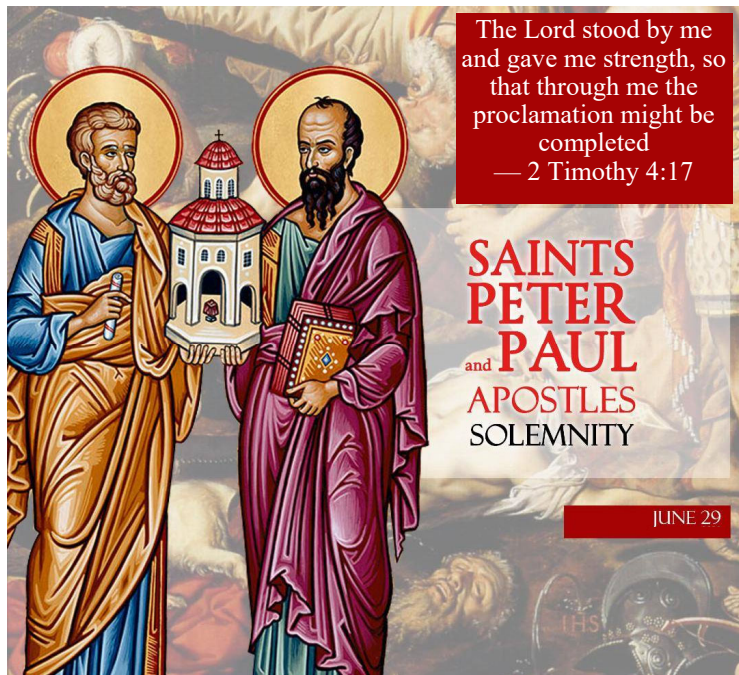

Welcome to our parish. We invite you to register, as soon as possible. Registration forms are available in the office during office hours, in the Tower Room or on our parish website. Though a rather simple act, registration allows the parish to know how many families live in the parish. It also provides an official record of your membership and is essential for sacramental preparations and sponsorship certification.

Sacrament of Baptism

Parents must be registered members of the Parish and in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. Participation in the Pre-Baptismal Program is required. Parents must register by calling the parish office.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least six months in advance. Participation in Marriage Preparation Workshop is required.

Sacrament of Anointing

The sacrament is celebrated upon request prior to surgery or at the time of illness. Please notify the Parish office of the illness or hospitalization of a parishioner.

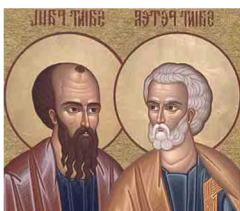

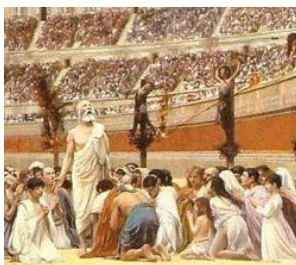

SAINTS OF THE DAY

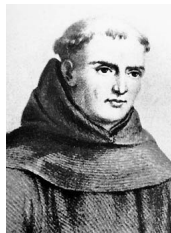
June 29 Peter and Paul Peter died around 64 in Rome under Nero; Galilean fisherman; spokesman for the 12 who became "Prince of the Apostles" two epistles are ascribed to him; patron of those in the fishing industry. Paul was martyred in Rome around 67; Pharisee who became the "Apostle of the Gentiles"; his letters may be dated from 50-65; patron of the lay apostolate, the Cursillo movement and Catholic Action. Both are the principal patrons of Rome.



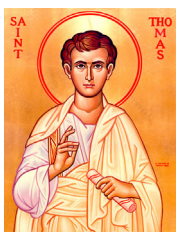
June 30 First Martyrs of the Holy Roman Church Died in 64; honoring those many Christians who were tortured, crucified and burned alive in Nero's garden on the Vatican Hill.



July 1 Junipero Serra Died in 1784; from Spain; a missionary who arrived in New Spain in 1750; established 9 of the California missions; baptized over 6,000 native people.



July 3 Thomas Died in the 1st century; apostle; his doubting gave way to faith when he saw the risen Lord; associated with founding the Church in south India; patron of builders, India and Pakistan.

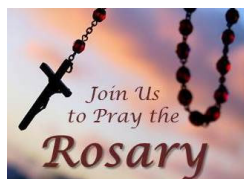


July 5 Anthony Zaccaria

Died in 1539 at age 36; doctor turned priest; popular preacher who founded in Milan the Clerics Regular of St. Paul; sought collaboration between the clergy and the laity; promoted frequent communion.



July 5 Elizabeth of Portugal Died in 1336; named after her great-aunt, St. Elizabeth of Hungary; queen and mother; lover of the poor; peacemaker in the royal family; later a Franciscan tertiary; patroness of Catholic charities.

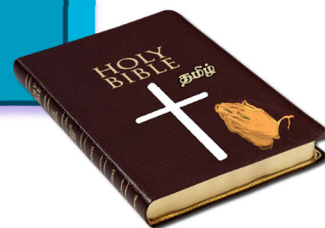
