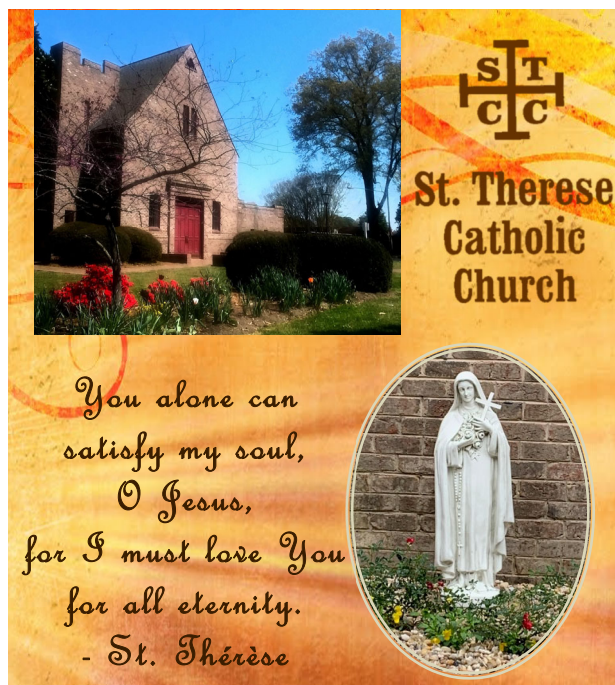

Welcome to our parish. We invite you to register, as soon as possible. Registration forms are available in the office during office hours, in the Tower Room or on our parish website. Though a rather simple act, registration allows the parish to know how many families live in the parish. It also provides an official record of your membership and is essential for sacramental preparations and sponsorship certification.

Sacrament of Baptism

Parents must be registered members of the Parish and in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. Participation in the Pre-Baptismal Program is required. Parents must register by calling the parish office.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least six months in advance. Participation in Marriage Preparation Workshop is required.

Sacrament of Anointing

The sacrament is celebrated upon request prior to surgery or at the time of illness. Please notify the Parish office of the illness or hospitalization of a parishioner.

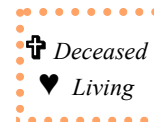

required for all parents who will have their child baptized at St. Therese. We will not schedule a baptism until the parents have attended the class.

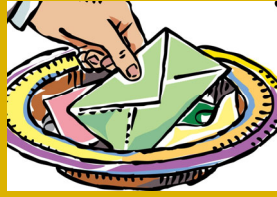
NOTE: Any parishioner that will be a godparent at St. Therese IS REQUIRED TO ATTEND. Those that will be a godparent in another parish may attend.

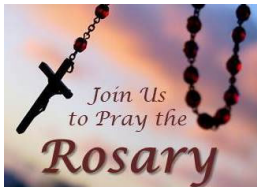

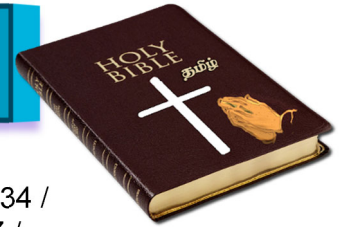

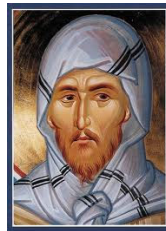

June 9 Blessed Virgin Mary,

Mother of God On February 11

Divine Worship issued a Decree implementing

Pope Francis' decision that this memorial be

inscribed in the General Roman Calendar and

observed on the Monday following Pentecost.

The joyous veneration given to the Mother of

God, in light of reflection on the mystery of Christ and on his

nature, cannot ignore the figure of a woman, the Virgin Mary,

who is both the Mother of Christ and Mother of

the Church.

June 11 Barnabas

Died in the 1st century;

preached the gospel in Antioch; companion of

Paul; attended the Council of

Jerusalem; martyred.

June 13 Anthony of Padua

Died in

1231 at age 36; priest; devoted

student of scripture; first friar to

teach theology to his fellow friars; gifted orator and

preacher; patron saint of Portugal, of the poor and

of lost articles.
