Welcome to our parish. We invite you to register, as soon as possible. Registration forms are available in the office during office hours, in the Tower Room or on our parish website. Though a rather simple act, registration allows the parish to know how many families live in the parish. It also provides an official record of your membership and is essential for sacramental preparations and sponsorship certification.

Sacrament of Baptism

Parents must be registered members of the Parish and in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. Participation in the Pre-Baptismal Program is required. Parents must register by calling the parish office.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least six months in advance. Participation in Marriage Preparation Workshop is required.

Sacrament of Anointing

The sacrament is celebrated upon request prior to surgery or at the time of illness. Please notify the Parish office of the illness or hospitalization of a parishioner.

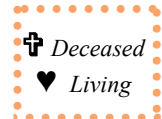

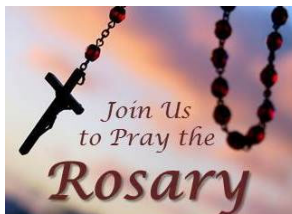

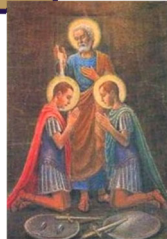

SAINTS OF THE DAY

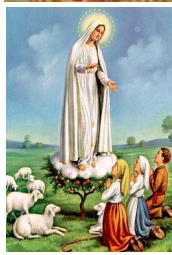
May 12 Nereus and Achilles Died at the end of the 1st century; they were Praetorian soldiers who converted to Christianity; beheaded.



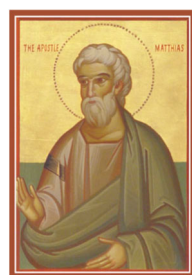
May 12 Pancras Died around 304; a Syrian or Phrygian orphan who came to Rome where he was converted to Christianity; beheaded at age 14.



May 13 Our Lady of Fatima Our Lady of Fatima is venerated under this title following apparitions to three shepherd children in Portugal in 1917. The message of Fatima includes a call to conversion of heart, repentance from sin, and prayer, especially the Rosary.



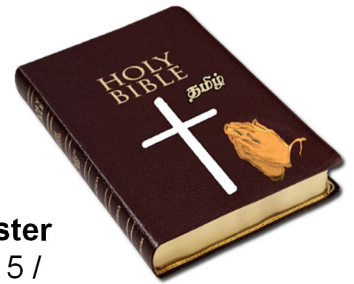
May 14 Matthias Died in the 1st century; chosen to replace Judas; qualified because he witnessed Jesus' ministry and resurrection; said to have suffered martyrdom either at Colchis or in Jerusalem.



May 15 Isidore Died in 1130; layman whose wife, Maria de la Cabeza is also a saint; farm laborer associated with miracles; patron of Madrid, of farmers and of rural communities.

11am Mass one Sunday a month.**

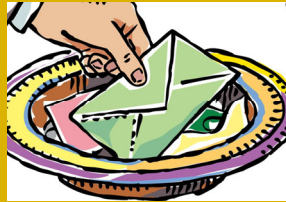

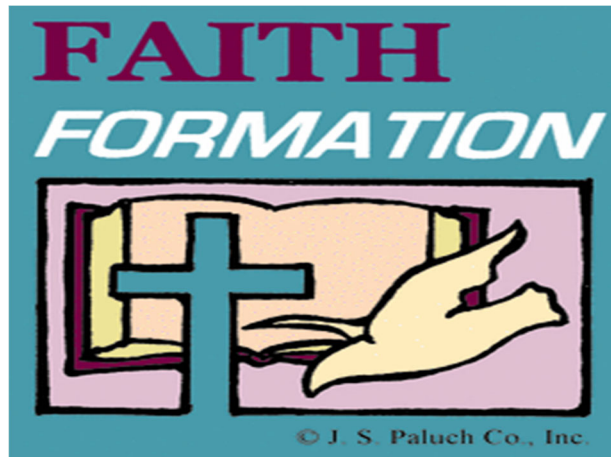
