It also provides an official record of your membership and is essential for sacramental preparations and sponsorship certification.

Sacrament of Baptism

Parents must be registered members of the Parish and in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. Participation in the Pre-Baptismal Program is required. Parents must register by calling the parish office.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least six months in advance. Participation in Marriage Preparation Workshop is required.

Sacrament of Anointing

The sacrament is celebrated upon request prior to surgery or at the time of illness. Please notify the Parish office of the illness or hospitalization of a parishioner.

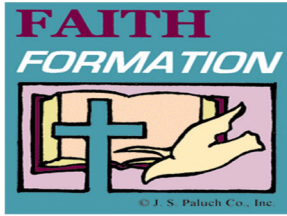

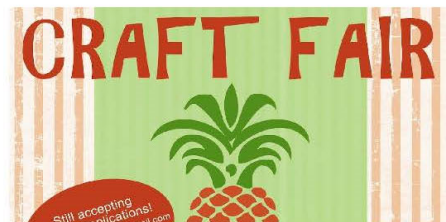

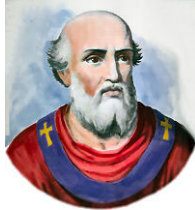

SAINTS OF THE DAY

May 18 **John I** Died in 526; elected Pope in 523; from Tuscany; introduced the Alexandrian computation of the date of Easter; led an embassy to Constantinople to discuss Emperor Justin I's policy toward Arians in the East; not satisfying the demands of Theodoric, the Arian king in Ravenna, and not knowing his fate, John died there, a wretched man, ill and worn out from his travels; buried in Rome.



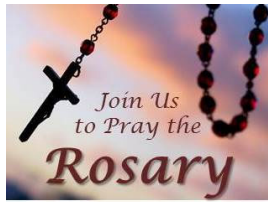
May 20 **Bernardine of Sienna** Died in 1444; famous reformer and eloquent preacher who traveled throughout Italy; encouraged devotion to the Holy Name of Jesus; known for his use of the monogram, IHS (Greek name for Jesus); patron of advertisers.



May 21 **Christopher Magallanes and Companions** Died between 1915 and 1937; 21 priests and 3 laymen who were shot or hung for their association with the Cristero uprising which opposed the anti-Catholic Mexican government.



May 22 **Rita of Cascia** Died in 1457; born in Umbria; lived with a brutal husband and had two sons; after the murder of her husband, she urged forgiveness in contrast to the customary vendetta of her day; became an Augustinian nun, spent 40 years in prayer, contemplation and service to the sick and poor; patron of desperate situations.

heed Padre Pio's admonition: "Love Our Lady, make others love her. Always say your Rosary and say it well."

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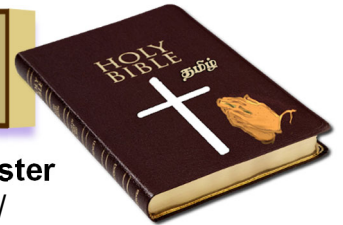
