It also provides an official record of your membership and is essential for sacramental preparations and sponsorship certification.

Sacrament of Baptism

Parents must be registered members of the Parish and in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. Participation in the Pre-Baptismal Program is required. Parents must register by calling the parish office.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least six months in advance. Participation in Marriage Preparation Workshop is required.

Sacrament of Anointing

The sacrament is celebrated upon request prior to surgery or at the time of illness. Please notify the Parish office of the illness or hospitalization of a parishioner.

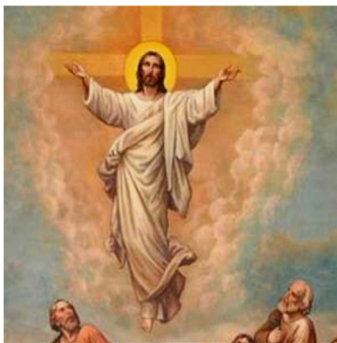

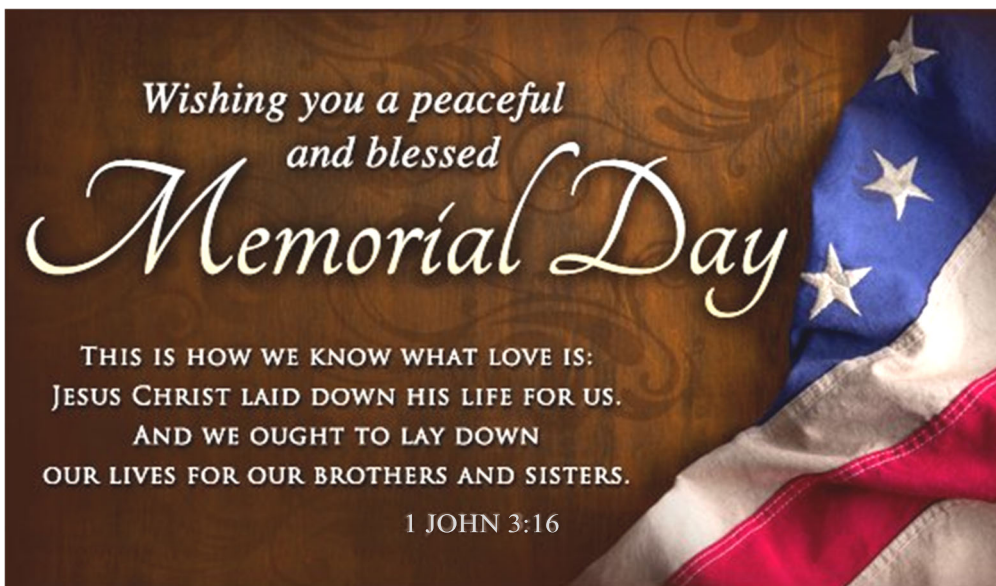


PARISH NIGHT AT WILSON TOBS

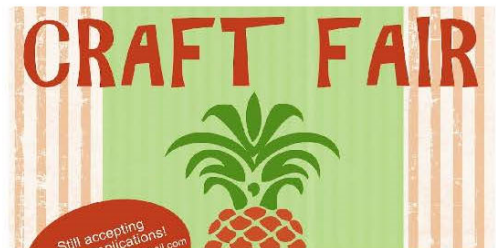

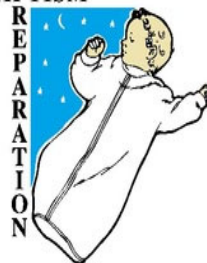

please call the church office to schedule an appointment.**

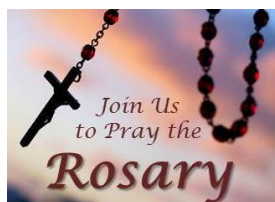

SAINTS OF THE DAY

May 25 Bede the Venerable Died in 735; called "Venerable" while still living; wrote Scriptural expositions, commentaries and homilies; known as the "Father of English history."



May 25 Gregory VII Died in 1085; pope; championed reform of the clergy against simony, clerical marriage and lay investiture, leading to the excommunication of Henry IV; expanded the authority of the Roman See.



May 25 Mary Magdalene de'Pazzi Died in 1607; Carmelite mystic of Florence who led a hidden life of prayer and self-denial, praying particularly for the renewal of the Church; instrumental in the reform of her Order.



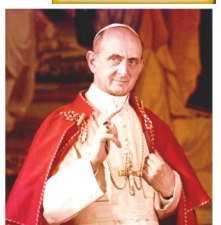
May 26 Philip Neri Died in 1595; founded the Congregation of Priests of the Oratory to promote holiness of priestly life and foster effective preaching; noted for his joyful and simple spirit.



May 27 Augustine of Canterbury Died in 604 or 605; monk of Mt. Coelius in Rome; sent with 40 other monks to England; baptized Ethelbert, king of Kent; ordained bishop in 597; established the Sees of Canterbury, London and Rochester; received the pallium as Primate of England.



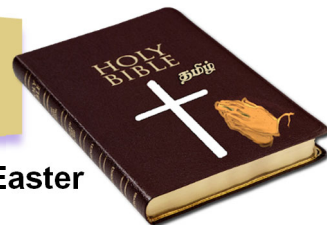
May 29 Pope Paul VI Died in 1978; born 1897 in Italy; during WWII, he worked to find shelter for persecuted Jews and refugees; appointed Archbishop of Milan in 1954; became a Cardinal in 1958 and Pope in 1963; brought Second Vatican Council to its completion; promulgated the Calendar, the Missal, the Liturgy of the Hours, the Pontifical and nearly all of the Ritual for the Roman Rite.

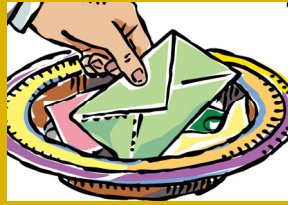
Free Catholic Materials for the Blind/Visually Impaired
