It also provides an official record of your membership and is essential for sacramental preparations and sponsorship certification.

Sacrament of Baptism

Parents must be registered members of the Parish and in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. Participation in the Pre-Baptismal Program is required. Parents must register by calling the parish office.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least six months in advance. Participation in Marriage Preparation Workshop is required.

Sacrament of Anointing

The sacrament is celebrated upon request prior to surgery or at the time of illness. Please notify the Parish office of the illness or hospitalization of a parishioner.

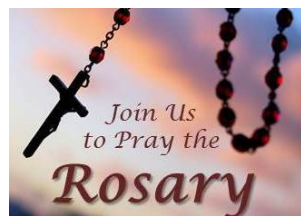

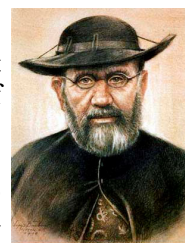

SAINTS OF THE DAY

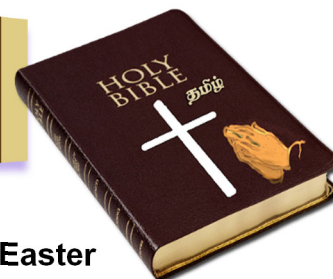
May 10 Damien de Veuster Died in 1889 at age 49; Belgian who joined the Fathers of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary; arrived in Honolulu in 1864; in 1873, he began his work on Moloka's, known as "Devil's Island", which was used as a colony for lepers; diagnosed with leprosy in 1885.



May 10 John of Ávila Died in 1569; Spanish priest, preacher, scholastic author and religious mystic; called the "Apostle of Andalusia" for his extensive ministry in that region of Spain; patron of Andalusia and the Spanish secular clergy; added to the calendar by Pope Francis in 2021.
